FIRST RUNNER AND FIRST WINNER FOR KEIAI NAUTIQUE

AGV Karwin Stud-based stallion **Keiai Nautique** sired a winner with his first runner when Henri-Alex Pantall's debutante **La Carmen** quickened up in good style to win the 1600m maiden for two-year-old fillies at Clairefontaine yesterday.

A €20,000 graduate of the Arqana v.2 Yearling Sale from the family of **Commander In Chief (Dancing Brave)**, who was wearing the silks of her owner-breeder Haras du Grand Lys, **La Carmen** broke alertly from stall two under Tony Piccone and was soon racing in second behind the pacesetting **Periwinkle (Muhaarar)**. Asked for more shortly after turning for home, **La**

Carmen quickly worked her way to the front and accelerated clear late on to win impressively by three and a half lengths.

La Carmen's win marked a superb start for the progeny of **Keiai Nautique**, an 11-year-old son of **Deep Impact** who was bred by Takae Bokujo in Japan. Trained domestically by Osamu Hirata, he was a high-class two-year-old and went on to win the Gr.1 NHK Mile Cup at Tokyo at three. Continuing to compete at a high level in Japan as he got older, he also enjoyed a brief stint with Matthew Smith in Australia towards the end of his career, demonstrating his versatility by finishing fourth in the Gr.1 Winx Stakes over 1400m and the Gr.1 Mackinnon Stakes over 2000m.

Keiai Nautique began his stallion career in France in 2023 with Ambre and Gregory Vayre at Karwin Farm in Normandy, covering almost 130 mares across his first three seasons. He was available at a fee of €3,000 during the 2026 campaign, although that was expected to be the last season overseen by the Vayre family as Karwin Farm was put up for sale earlier this year.

One of five winners out of the dual Japanese Gr.3 winner **Keiai Gerbera (Smarty Jones)**, **Keiai Nautique** is a full-brother to the triple Gr.1 winner and sire **Fierce Impact**, who was crowned Joint Champion Middle Distance Horse in Australia in 2019/20.

SAD LOSS OF DUAL PURPOSE SIRE PLANTEUR

Chapel Stud sadly announced the passing of its established Flat and National Hunt stallion **Planteur** yesterday.

Roisin Close, Stud Manager at Chapel Stud, said: "Sadly, **Planteur** passed away today from natural causes shortly after being turned out into his paddock.

"We feel incredibly fortunate to have been entrusted with **Planteur** on behalf of Simon Davies at DahlBury. He played such an important role at Chapel Stud, consistently well-supported by breeders who recognised his quality, and it is particularly sad to lose him just as we were beginning to see the results of those early books on the racecourse. We believe the true impact of his loss will become even more apparent over the coming years as his progeny continue to fulfil their potential.

"Beyond his achievements as a stallion, **Planteur** was a much-loved member of the team. He was a true gentleman to handle, with a kind temperament that made him a favourite of everyone who worked with him. He will be greatly missed by us all, but we are immensely proud of the legacy he leaves behind."

The sire of Champion Stayer and three-time Gr.1 winner **Trueshan**, as well as dual Gr.1-winning chaser **Gran Diose**, **Planteur** had firmly established himself as a successful dual-purpose stallion. A son of **Danehill Dancer**, he was also an outstanding performer on the racecourse himself, winning the Gr.1 Prix Ganay, the Gr.2 Prix d'Harcourt and the Gr.2 Prix Noailles. He either won or was placed in 12 Group and Stakes races during a distinguished career, earning more than £2.2m in prize money.

Simon Davies of DahlBury said: "We are so sorry to have lost **Planteur** and especially feel for Roisin and the entire team at Chapel Stud, who cared for him so well. His British-bred progeny were just beginning to make their mark, and while it is heartbreaking to lose him, there is comfort in knowing that many more of his offspring, including some of our own, will be reaching the racecourse over the coming years and continuing his legacy."

BELIEVERS REWARDED AS BINT ARCHANGE BOUNCES BACK

It has been a stellar period for Mickley Stud's **Ubettabelieveit**, who added a new Stakes winner yesterday when **Bint Archange**

landed the 5f Listed Dragon Stakes at Sandown for owner Jaber Abdullah and trainer Richard Hughes. The victory came six days after **Tokaido** landed the Gr.3 Prix du Bois for trainer Amy Murphy, becoming a first Group winner for the sire in the process.

Benefiting from the assistance of Ryan Moore, she broke on terms and was allowed to stride on to the front, settling well with a clear path and just off the trailblazer **Bill The Bull (Coulsty)**. Asked to pick up at halfway, she coasted to the front with relative ease and stayed there for a smart bounce back to form after a disappointing effort in the Gr.2 Queen Mary Stakes last time out. The 5f track at Sandown is rarely without a hard luck story but on

this occasion it was exempt from controversy, with the slowly-away **A Bear Affair (Kodi Bear)** running on well with a clear passage for second, beaten half a length, and **Miss Lizzy (Oasis Dream)** quickening up from the pack to take third a length and a quarter further back.

Bred by Kildaragh Stud, which sold her at Tattersalls Ireland September Yearling Sale for €45,000 to Rabbah Bloodstock, she is the first Stakes winner out of the three-time winning juvenile **Archange (Arcano)**, who has a commendable strike rate with five winners from six foals to date. The next dam **Carinae (Nureyev)** was multiple Listed-placed. Third on debut at Newmarket, **Bint Archange** was impressive in getting off the mark in a valuable novice at Ascot over 5f by four lengths, before disappointing back there at the Royal Meeting.

Hughes had no explanation for her poor effort but was naturally delighted to see her back to form yesterday: "I nearly fell off the stand at Ascot, watching that," he said jokingly. "It was horrendous. She went there in great form and I couldn't have been happier with her and then she never beat a horse. I have no idea why it went so badly. It's character building stuff," he told Lydia Hislop on Racing TV. "She was meant to go to France tomorrow but when this race cut up we came here as it saved us travelling. She was back to her old self today." In terms of her next target, regarding an entry in the Weatherbys Super Sprint over course and distance, Hughes said: "I'll speak to Jaber. There is a lot of money up for grabs, she'll have to carry a penalty now but it shouldn't stop her and she'll have a huge chance." Adding a compliment for the stallion **Ubettabelieveit**,

whose master Richard Kent was present to enjoy the victory, Hughes said: *"I've always been a true believer in the horse, he had lovely, magnificent yearlings and this one has proven it again."*

VARIAN'S FRANKEL GELDING CONTINUES TO PROGRESS

Sallaal (Frankel) backed up his wildly impressive win in handicap company at the Derby Festival with a straightforward success in the Listed Gala Stakes over 1m2f at Sandown yesterday.

The Roger Varian-trained four-year-old had blitzed his rivals by six and a half lengths in a Class 2 handicap over this trip at Epsom last month, earning a 12lb rise in the weights to an official mark of 119. That inevitably meant his next outing would be in Stakes company, and he passed yesterday's test with flying colours.

A little keen early on in the hands of Ray Dawson, the odds-on favourite raced in second as last year's Cambridgeshire winner **Boiling Point (Too Darn Hot)** took the six runners along. Two lengths behind the leader as the field straightened up for home, **Sallaal** was shaken up with a quarter of a mile left to run and worked his way to the lead at the furlong pole. Although unable to break clear as he had done against inferior opposition the time before, the Godolphin-bred gelding knuckled down pleasingly to beat solid yardstick **Persica (New Bay)** by a length and three quarters. **Glacius (Too Darn Hot)** was a neck away in third.

This was a fifth win in nine starts for **Sallaal**, who had failed to win in three previous attempts in Listed company and was gelded after finishing fifth at Leopardstown at the backend of last season.

Owned by Sheikh Ahmed Al Maktoum, he was also second in the City and Suburban Handicap on his first start of this year and will be on a hat-trick wherever he goes next, with his trainer nominating the Gr.3 Rose of Lancaster Stakes as a possible option.

The winning trainer Roger Varian said: *"I am very happy. It was a very different test yesterday compared to Epsom when there was a big field and a strong gallop. Yesterday was more tactical and it was slightly different ground. I was just a bit nervous because it was a different set up and I'm not sure he's the bravest, although he is getting better. He got to the front early and you see results change here inside the final furlong, so it wasn't over until it was over. But he was good I thought and dominant crossing the line. It was a strong race and I'm happy with him. It will be small steps. There is no rush with him as he is a horse that hopefully should be around for a couple of years. I had in my mind that if we won yesterday, we could look at something like the Rose of Lancaster at Haydock next month. There are other options too, we have a Listed under our belt now and don't need to go flying up the ladder. We will stay at ten furlongs with him. He'll stay a bit further, but he raced a bit freely in Ray's hands yesterday because there was no gallop on and he did well to race in that position just in behind the leader."*

He is one of eight winners out of the **Selkirk** mare **Nahrain**, who provided Roger Varian with his first top-level winner when landing the 2011 Gr.1 Prix de l'Opera. The mare's previous winners include the 2024 Gr.1 1,000 Guineas heroine **Elmalka (Kingman)**, also trained by Varian, and the triple Gr.1 winner and sire **Benbatl (Dubawi)**. The second dam is the Gr.2 Ribblesdale Stakes winner

and Gr.1 Oaks second **Bahr (Generous)**, and the family can be traced directly back to the multiple Gr.1-winning 1976 New Zealand Horse of the Year **La Mer (Copenhagen II)**.

DERBY SECOND LAZY GRIFF ARRIVES ON STAYING SCENE

Lazy Griff (Protectionist) made all of the running to comfortably win the Listed Esher Stakes over 2m at Sandown yesterday for trainer Charlie Johnston and jockey Billy Loughnane.

Sent straight to the front in the silks of Middleham Park Racing, the odds-on favourite momentarily jinked left when turning out onto the second circuit but otherwise enjoyed a trouble-free journey. Gradually upping the tempo from halfway, he shook off the attentions of **Paradias (Kodiac)** approaching the final furlong and galloped on resolutely to win by two and three-quarter lengths. **Lady Vivian (Camelot)** stayed on best of the rest to grab second, shading **Paradias** for that position by a neck.



Last season's Gr.1 Derby runner-up **Lazy Griff (Protectionist)** got back to winning ways in yesterday's 2m Listed Marathon (registered as *The Esher Stakes*).

Bred by Gestüt Westerberg and also part-owned by G Griffiths, **Lazy Griff** won the Gr.3 Prix de Conde over 1800m at Chantilly as a two-year-old and went on the Classic trail last season. A length and a half behind **Lambourn (Australia)** when second in the Gr.3 Chester Vase on his three-year-old return, he would go on to chase home the same horse when second in the Gr.1 Derby and third in the Gr.1 Irish Derby. A subsequent injury denied him a crack at the Gr.1 St Leger, and he wasn't seen again until finishing third in the Gr.3 Henry II Stakes at Sandown in late May.

Charlie Johnston mentioned the Gr.1 Goodwood Cup and Gr.1 Irish St Leger as possible targets for his four-year-old colt. He

added: "It was probably never going to be a race that would see him at his very best, but it was another stepping stone for him, and I didn't feel I learnt enough from his race here in the Henry II Stakes to jump straight in at the highest level [in the Gold Cup]. I felt we needed another run, and this provided that, and it is a case of job done."

"Billy said he nearly ran out at the top bend, and all I could think going round is this horse is well named because isn't he lazy! Billy was just having to be at him the whole way, and I think there was plenty more in the tank if it was needed."

Bought for €75,000 by Jeremy Brummitt at the BBAG September Yearling Sale, **Lazy Griff** is a full-brother to the Gr.3 Bavarian Classic winner **Lambo**, and they are among four winners out of the Danish-bred **Linarda (Rock Of Gibraltar)**, who won four times in Switzerland. The wider family includes numerous black-type performers in North America, such as the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 (then) Delaware Handicap runner-up **She's All In (Include)**.

CHARLIE'S CANNON ADDED AS A WILD CARD TO THE TATTERSALLS JULY SALE

The recent debut winner **Charlie's Cannon** is the latest addition to next week's Tattersalls July Sale, set to be offered by Jamie Railton as **Lot 504G** on Wednesday, 8th July.

The three-year-old son of **New Bay** put up a commanding performance and broke his maiden tag by half a length in Thursday's 7f novice contest at Kempton Park for trainer Ralph Beckett under Rossa Ryan for owners Palmont.

The chesnut gelding was slow to break and, despite displaying signs of greenness, passed the whole field to earn a Timeform rating of 81p. Out of a half-sister to the Gr.1-winning Champion European Two-Year-Old Colt **Toormore (Arakan)**, as well as the

two-time Gr.2 winner **Estidkhaar (Dark Angel)**, **Charlie's Cannon** went through the ring as a yearling at Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale and was knocked down to Alex Elliott for 110,000gns from Redpender Stud.

CONSTITUTION RIVER HEADS ECLIPSE STAKES SEVEN

Constitution River (Wootton Bassett) will face six rivals as he takes on older horses for the first time in the 1m2f Gr.1 Eclipse Stakes at Sandown this afternoon.

The Aidan O'Brien-trained three-year-old colt displayed great promise in three outings last season, notably winning the Gr.2 Futurity Stakes, and has looked all class in two runs so far this term. He returned with a dominant seven-length win in the Listed Dee Stakes at Chester and then overcame a wide draw to beat stablemates **Hawk Mountain (Wootton Bassett)** and **Montreal (Sea The Stars)** in a gripping renewal of Chantilly's Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club. He now bids to emulate **Vadeni (Churchill)**, who completed the Prix du Jockey Club/Eclipse Stakes double in 2022.

Hawk Mountain was less than a length behind **Constitution River** in the Prix du Jockey Club and is back for another crack as Aidan O'Brien seeks a record-extending tenth win in this race. Successful in the Gr.2 Beresford Stakes and Gr.1 Futurity Trophy Stakes as a juvenile last season, he won the Gr.3 Prix de Guiche on his return to action and is sure to have plenty of supporters as he aims to become the sixth consecutive three-year-old winner of this always highly anticipated generational clash. With Ryan Moore on **Constitution River**, Wayne Lordan takes the mount.

The Ballydoyle roster is completed by pacemaker **Flushing Meadows (Wootton Bassett)**, who was last seen finishing unplaced in the Britannia Stakes at Royal Ascot. Sean Levey rides.

Leading the charge for the older generation is the Owen Burrows-trained **Gethin**, a progressive son of the 2020 Eclipse Stakes winner **Ghaiyyath**. A six-length novice winner on his only start at two, he was twice Listed-placed during a light three-year-old campaign last year before impressively winning the Listed Magnolia Stakes on his comeback this spring. Snapped up by Wathnan Racing shortly afterwards, he has since run **Ombudsman (Night Of Thunder)** to a neck over course and distance (albeit in receipt of 7lb) in the Gr.3 Brigadier Gerard Stakes and fully merits this step up in class. James Doyle will ride. Wathnan will also field Harry Charlton's Gr.2-placed **King's Gambit (Saxon Warrior)**, who is there to ensure an even gallop under Jamie Spencer.

Another classy four-year-old set to take his chance is the Roger Varian-trained and Ray Dawson-ridden **Saddadd (Pinatubo)**, who won the Gr.3 Gordon Richards Stakes over this course and distance on his seasonal reappearance. There was plenty to admire about a subsequent third in the Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at the Curragh, a performance which demonstrated that the Sheikh Ahmed Al Maktoum-owned colt belongs at this level.

The line up is completed by the Donnacha O'Brien-trained three-year-old **A Boy Named Susie (Starspangledbanner)**, who has been knocking on the door in smart company for some time. Second in the Gr.1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud last season, he took third behind future Gr.1 Derby winner **Christmas Day (Camelot)** on his first run of this year and then finished a running-on fourth behind **Constitution River** in the Prix du Jockey Club. He can't be ruled out with Oisín Murphy set to do the steering.

USA

APPLEBY PAIR AMONGST FOUR ON THEIR TRAVELS TO SARATOGA

Contradictory to their names, tonight's Gr.1 Belmont Derby Stakes and Gr.1 Belmont Oaks Stakes will again take place at Saratoga, with Belmont Park still undergoing reconstruction and scheduled to reopen in September.

Since its inauguration in 2014, tonight's Belmont Derby Stakes has been won twice by Aidan O'Brien, the only successful raiding party. Last year, Charlie Fellowes came close with the slightly unlucky third-placed **Luther (Frankel)**, who chased home **Test Score (Lookin At Lucky)**, a second consecutive winner in the race for the British native and American-based trainer Graham

Motion. He will saddle the Stakes winner and Gr.2-placed **Turf Star (Caravaggio)** in a bid for a hat-trick in the three-year-old 1¼m contest. Both Simon Crisford, and Charlie Appleby stand in the way of the conquest, with Crisford sending their Gr.2 German 2,000 Guineas winner **Title Role (Too Darn Hot)** and Appleby sending his Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas third **Pacific Avenue (Dubawi)**. The pair have met before when filling the first two places home in that order in the Listed Jumeirah 2,000 Guineas at Meydan back in February, and will face eight other contenders tonight at 10.20pm (BST).

A pair of European fillies will also contest the ten-strong Belmont Oaks Stakes. Appleby sends the one-time Gr.1 Oaks contender and Gr.1 Irish 1,000 Guineas third **Abashiri (Frankel)**. Still lightly-raced, she will make her fourth start and will be partnered by William Buick, who has been on her in each of her three starts. It seems remiss to call this season challenging for Appleby, who has won seven Stakes races, including a pair of Gr.1s, but by the stable's lofty standards, it is quieter than usual. He saddled the winner **Cinderella's Dream (Shamardal)** two years ago and having missed last year, will aim to maintain his form at Saratoga, a track where he has enjoyed much success.

The trophy has been taken back to Tipperary on a few occasions, most recently with the Fozzy Stack-trained **Aspen Grove (Justify)** in 2023. Aidan O'Brien has won it twice and his son Donnacha saddles the Gr.3 winner **Kensington Lane (Starspangledbanner)** in an ambitious second tilt at a top level contest for owners Agave Racing Stables, Medallion Racing and Evan Trommer. The early market suggests **Abashiri** is the one to fear, though the home defence is headed up by the two-time Gr.2 winner **Imaginationhelady (Not This Time)** from Brendan Walsh's formidable squad. The race is scheduled for 9.05pm.

HUNGARY

HUNGARIAN DERBY FIELD BURSTING WITH IRISH, FRENCH AND GERMAN INFLUENCE

The 104th Hungarian Derby takes place tomorrow, 5th July, at Kincsem Park, with 16 three-year-olds set to go to post in the 2400m contest.

There are at least two familiar names featuring amongst the declared field, with Silvestre de Sousa partnering the Paizs Gabor-trained **Aranykor (Seahenge)**. He most recently finished second

over 2000m and has placed in local Graded Stakes company.

Harry Davies joins de Sousa in riding for the same trainer and rides **Hanak**, a former Aga Khan Studs homebred for Johnny Murtagh in Ireland. The son of **Palace Pier** won his maiden in May and has placed in handicap company since, his first attempt at 2000m.

There are four Irish-breds going to post, including **Dancer Boy**, a son of **Soldier's Call**, who was sold by Galbertstown Stables to Bobby O'Ryan for €13,000 at the Goffs Autumn Yearling Sale. He is trained by Stanislav Georgiev and will be ridden by Aleksandar Sasic and tries 2400m for the first time. Breeders Laurence Kennedy and Cormac O'Tighearnaigh can enjoy watching **Deep Blue Sky** taking on a Classic. The daughter of **Supremacy** is another graduate of the Goffs Autumn Sale, where she was picked up by Tahi Stud Ltd for €2,500 from Moyfinn Stud.

Formerly with Francis-Henri Graffard, the Tally-Ho Stud-bred **Sorority Girl (Mehmas)** is one of four fillies in total to take on the local Derby. Unraced in France, she changed hands for €4,500 at this year's Arqana February Sale when purchased by Aurel Mazilu.

There is a quintet of French-breds, including a son of in-form sire **Romanised, Fenomenális**. De Sousa's mount **Aranykor** is another bred in France, along with **Mario (The Grey Gatsby)**, **Neptune Des Clos (Toronado)** and **Star Champion (French Fifteen)**.

DEEP FIELD YOUNGSTER REACHES HK\$9.2M AT HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL SALE

A vibrant 2026 Hong Kong International Sale saw 16 horses sold at Sha Tin yesterday, with a **Deep Field** gelding topping the sale at HK\$9.2m for purchaser Alan Hu.

Sold as **Lot 2**, the bay gelding is by four-time Champion Sire in Hong Kong **Deep Field** while his dam is **Hussterical (Beneteau)**. Hu, who also scooped **Lot 1** – a son of **Per Incanto** – for HK\$4.6m, set the tone for a night of intense bidding where 11 of the 16 lots returned higher than HK\$4m prices and six of these surpassed the HK\$5m mark.



Lot 2, a three-year-old gelding by **Deep Field**, topped yesterday's Hong Kong International Sale when knocked down for HK\$9.2m to Hu Chiu Lun Alan.

A **Savabeel** gelding, offered as **Lot 4**, sold for HK\$5.2m to owner Yu Lung before a second son of **Savabeel** – **Lot 10** – sold to Qin Fang for HK\$5.4m. **Savabeel** has more than 60 wins in Hong Kong, led by the likes of seven-time victors **Rattan**, **Flame Hero** and **Ever Laugh**.

An attractive gelding by **Written Tycoon**, sire of Gr.2 winner **Tomodachi Kokoroe**, went to The Huw Syndicate for HK\$4.6m before Tang Kin Nam secured the first of two horses from South Africa – **Lot 6**, a son of **Gimmethgreenlight** for HK\$3.8m.

Austin Miu landed **Lot 7** – a bay son of **Dundeel** for HK\$5.4m – before a chestnut son of **Mehmas**, sold as **Lot 8**, fell to owner Yan Ming for HK\$5m.

Overall, the total sale amount returned from 16 lots this evening was HK\$76.2m, up from the HK\$45.1m total of last year from 15 lots, while the average in 2026 was HK\$4.76m compared to 2025, when the average was slightly over HK\$3m.

Lot 9 was the second son of **Deep Field** to go through the ring, netting HK\$6.6m from Cheung Kwong Kwan as a son of **Calyx** fell for HK\$3.4m to **Lam Wai Ying**.

The likes of **Helios Express**, **Little Paradise** and **Victor The Winner** headline **Toronado's** progeny currently racing in Hong Kong, and **Lot 13** will aim to make his mark in the new season for owner Stephan Chan, who went to HK\$4.6m for the bay gelding.

Late sire **Wootton Bassett** was represented with **Lot 14**, an attractive bay out of the mare **Semillon (Australia)**, who was purchased for HK\$3m by Leung Shek On, who currently races fellow Hong Kong International Sale graduate **Kingly Demeanor (Oasis Dream)**, the winner of four races in Hong Kong and who features at Sha Tin's 11-race fixture today.

The second of the South African duo, a son of **What A Winter** sold as **Lot 15**, was secured by Cheung Kun Tong for HK\$3.4m. **Starspangledbanner**, sire of Gr.1 hero **California Spangle**, was represented by **Lot 17**, which was purchased by The Amazing Family Syndicate for HK\$4.8m. The Patch Syndicate reached HK\$3.2m for **Lot 19**, a brown gelding by **I Am Invincible**, while **Lot 22** closed out the evening for HK\$4m to owner Tam Jin Rong.

Mr Danny Rolston, Executive Manager, International Sale/ Owners Advisory Services, The Hong Kong Jockey Club, said: "We've experienced a really healthy sale here tonight. There's a really good increase in the average price, and I think we've got a few factors right this year. But the message which comes out of today is the owners' appetite for horse ownership in Hong Kong is really responding well to the bonus structure, increases in prize money and the initiatives the Club is putting into place.

"The first key indicator we saw towards having a good sale was the large increase in ballot applications this year. So, with a higher

application rate for the ballot, more permits in the market and having the sale after the ballot this year – I think we had all of the ingredients right for a good sale.

“This is only part of the journey; it’s taken us two years with these horses to get here and we’ve only sold around 50 per cent of the horses we bought in that year. We’re holding the bar really, really high. We only want to bring the absolute best horses, the soundest horses, and the horses with the most ability and the best temperaments to the market. I think we did that today with a really reinvigorated appetite for ownership – the Hong Kong can do spirit; I think we’ve seen that come out to play tonight.”

The median price tonight was HK\$4.6m, while in 2025 the median reached HK\$2.6m.

BHA CONFIRMS ADDITIONAL FLAT FIXTURE AT WOLVERHAMPTON ON FRIDAY, 17TH JULY

The British Horseracing Authority (BHA) has announced that an additional Flat fixture has been scheduled at Wolverhampton on Friday, 17th July. This follows The Jockey Club's announcement earlier this week that Haydock Park's next two fixtures on 17th and 18th July have been cancelled, with the fixture on Saturday, 18th July moving to Nottingham on the same date.
